Exploration Drilling for Geothermal Project in Yunotani, Minamiaso-mura, Kumamoto

RENOVA, Inc. (hereinafter "RENOVA"), FOCUS Co., Ltd. and DENERGY K.K. announce that the companies will begin drilling a structural boring well to identify the potential of geothermal resources at Yunotani, Minamiaso-mura, Aso-gun, Kumamoto Prefecture on September 13, 2017, in response to permission for drilling granted by the Governor of Kumamoto Prefecture on August 10, 2017. The three companies are planning to develop local geothermal resources.

Mr. Seiichi Kira, mayor of Minamiaso-mura, commented on the development of geothermal resources at Yunotani: "This project is one of the symbols of the recovery from the earthquakes hitting the Kumamoto and its surroundings in April 2016, and plays a significant role to support the local economy. Development and operation of renewable energy, namely geothermal energy, have a significant social meaning. We expect that this important initiative will become reality in Minamiaso-mura."

- Area: Yunotani, Minamiaso-mura, Kumamoto Prefecture (in the land owned by a subsidiary of FOCUS Co., Ltd.)
- Survey contents:

1. Drilling: Drilling an exploration well

2. Well logging and testing: Investigating the characteristics of the well

3. Integrated analysis: Estimating the potential of geothermal resources from the results and

formulating a development plan

We have been conducting intensive hot spring monitoring in and around the survey field with another operator group since 2015.
